

JUNIOR SUMMER SCHOOL



PROGRAMME DETAILS

The Future Leaders programme has been designed for students with a good basic knowledge of English, who want to prepare for studying in an English-speaking environment. Lessons will introduce students to global themes, such as the environment, technology, and active citizenship, and will help them to improve their soft skills, such as teamwork, leadership, and problem-solving.

This course includes:

25 hours of combined leadership skills and English lessons per week

Intermediate B1 level and above

Two classes per morning and an afternoon workshop activity
