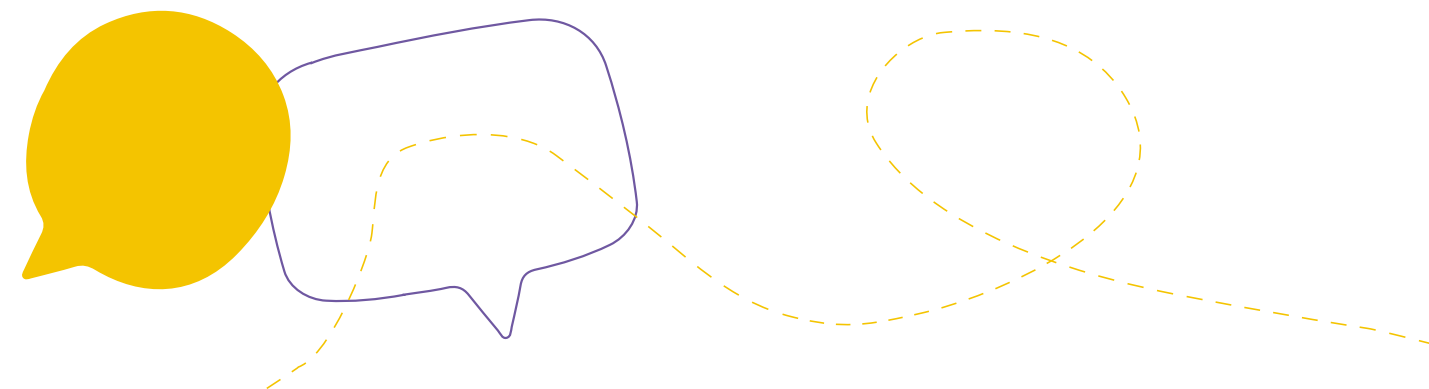

## ★ PROGRAMME DETAILS

Lessons will introduce students to global themes, such as the environment, technology, and active citizenship, and will help them to improve their soft skills, such as teamwork, leadership, and problem-solving.

- Intermediate B1 level and above
- Two classes per morning and an afternoon workshop activity
