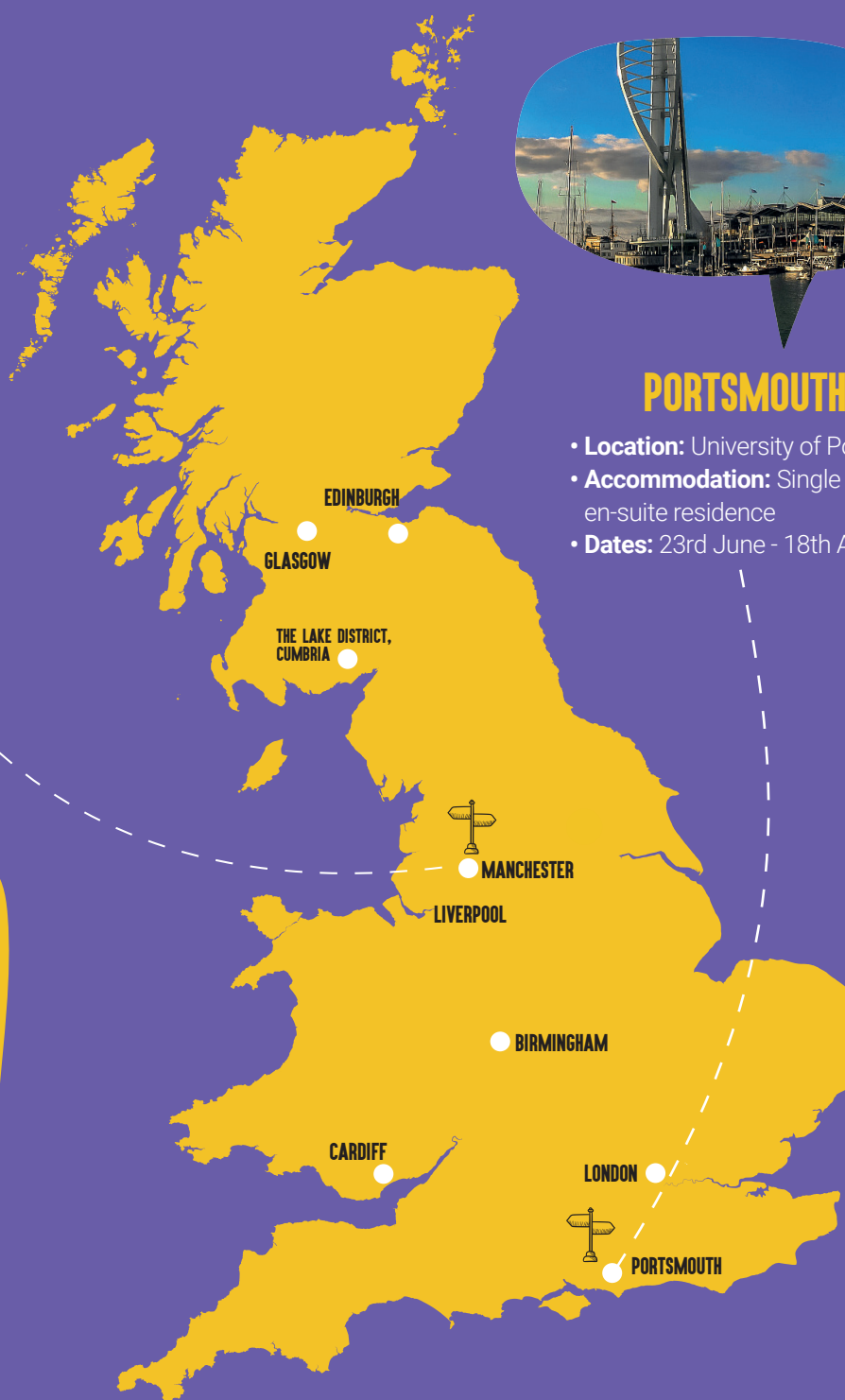

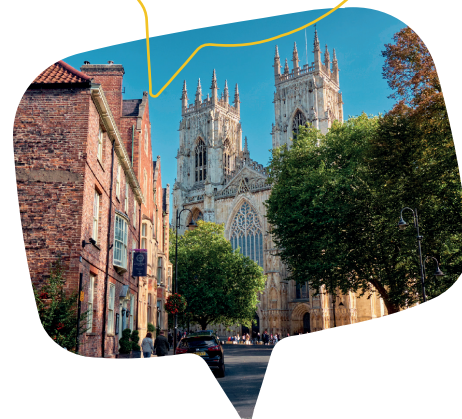
## Why Manchester?
