Why Manchester?


Commonly referred to as England's second city, Manchester is known for its unique Victorian architecture, world-famous football clubs, remarkable arts and culture, and legendary music scene.

As the world becomes more interconnected through trade, travel, and culture, the importance of empowering young people to understand the benefits and issues around globalisation increases.

This programme explores different aspects of leadership through topic-based lessons, empowering students by teaching them all the necessary skills required to succeed in becoming the young leaders of tomorrow.



PROGRAMME DETAILS

The Future Leaders programme has been designed for students with a good basic knowledge of English, who want to prepare for studying in an Englishspeaking environment. Lessons will introduce students to global themes, such as the environment, technology, and active citizenship, and will help them to improve their soft skills, such as teamwork, leadership, and problem-solving.

This course includes:

- 25 hours of combined leadership skills and English lessons per week
- Intermediate B1 level and above
- Two classes per morning and an afternoon workshop activity
- A variety of optional extra-curricular activities at weekends
- Evening activities
- Full day excursion on Saturday




